The polysubstance assessment tool is a novel method to capture polysubstance use (the use of more than one substance at the same time).

The polysubstance assessment tool is a novel method to capture polysubstance use (the use of more than one substance at the same time). It was created as a research administered version via REDCap as well as an app-based self administered version. The research administered tool captures high-risk polysubstance use (based on 6 high risk substances) while the app version captures all combinations.
